Dr. Adrienne Israel

Dr. Israel is Professor Emerita of History. She taught for 38 years at Guilford College where she worked to cast a broader light on the community in and around Guilford College and its role in the Underground Railroad. Dr. Israel's research contributed to greater public attention being given to Lavina Curry, New Garden Boarding School's first washerwoman and one of many Black agents on North Carolina's Underground Railroad. Lavina Curry helped to shepherd enslaved people from North Carolina to Indiana.

Dr. Meredith Summers

Dr. Summers is a native of Elon, North Carolina and proud graduate of Wake Forest University where she received two bachelor's degrees in sociology and religion with a concentration in family studies. She went on to graduate studies in sociology at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro and the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. She received an Executive Juris Doctorate as a dual enrollee at McKinney Law School of Indiana University and Purdue University Global.

Meredeth currently serves as the Chief of Staff and the Assistant Secretary to the Board of Trustees at Guilford College in Greensboro, North Carolina. She also faithfully serves on the President's Cabinet. Hailing various roles since 2011, she works closely with the popular Bryan Series, is a Title IX hearing officer, is responsible for executing Opening Convocation and Commencement Exercises and other major events on campus, and is the staff Director and Advisor for Voices of Victory, the College's gospel choir.
